Dear People of St. Mark's,

April 2025

We are moving through the season of Lent, which is an important and meaningful season that reaches its high point during Holy Week and concludes joyfully with Easter. This year, we have been celebrating Lent with special Wednesday evening events featuring delightful suppers and lectures on David, Solomon, and the Temple. It has been a wonderful time of fellowship and learning.

Please note, there will be no Wednesday night services or suppers on April 2 and April 9 due to my vacation. However, I have prepared a special sermon for Sunday, April 6, and I warmly invite you all to join together that morning for worship. Holy Week officially begins on Palm Sunday, April 13. We will hold special worship services on Maundy Thursday and Good Friday at (6:30) PM, leading us to our special Easter worship celebration on Sunday, April 20 at 9:30 AM. 


Volunteers to help cut & trim the grass needed!




