
ST. MARK'S DECEMBER 2024 NEWSLETTER

- Week 4: Luke 1:39-45, (46-55): The Joy of Christ's Presence. Mary and Elizabeth's joyous encounter reminds us that true joy comes from God's faithfulness and the presence of Christ.

I hope this series will inspire you to embrace the spirit of Advent and prepare your heart for the celebration of Christmas. 


CHRISTMAS POINSETTIAS


